BIBLE READINGS:

Matthew 16:18; Matthew 7:24; 1 Corinthians 10:4; Psalm 18:2; Exodus 33:22; Psalm 2:12

MATTHEW 16:18

On this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hell will not overcome it.

MATTHEW 7:24

If you hear my words and put them into practice you are wise, like one who builds their house on the rock.

1 CORINTHIANS 10:4

All drank the same spiritual drink; for they all drank from the spiritual rock that accompanied them, and that rock was Christ.

PSALM 18:2

The Lord is my rock, my fortress, and my savior. My God is my rock, in whom I take refuge. He is my shield and the strength of my salvation, my place of safety.

EXODUS 33:22

WEEKLY GUIDE

JULY 18, 2021

DISCUSSION:

What influences people's opinion of our church? From people they know or have met who attend our church? From our past reputation? Previous pastors? Perhaps they lump us in with other Christians they know. Could it be something as simple as the name of our church?

What does The Rock Church mean to you? What does the name of our church say about us? How might an outsider view the name of our church? What might the name of our church mean to someone who doesn't read the Bible or isn't familiar with Christianity or Jesus Christ?

How can connecting Biblical meaning to our church name help us? How can understanding some of the themes relating to The Rock help us better communicate what our church is about to others? How does our name connect with our vision for what our church can be? Why is it important this is congruent?

APPLICATION:

What impacted you the most from this lesson? What were your big takeaways? What will you apply to your life? How will you put what you learned into practice in your life this week?

SUMMARY:

Our identity in our community is important. How our community views us matters. Where do people shape their opinion of our church? Could it be something as simple as the name of our church? It's a good chance that's where people who are not familiar with us form their first impression.
