Takeaways

- Christ is supreme over everything
- Christianity is not "Christ Plus"
- Everything we need for salvation, growth, wisdom, and life is found in Jesus.
- Jesus Christ alone is sufficient.
- Continue in your faith. Remain established and firm. Refuse to drift in your relationship with Christ.

God's purpose is not simply conversion but maturity. Spiritual growth comes through knowing and doing God's will.

Examine Areas Where You Have Added "Plus Something"

Ask: Am I looking to success, entertainment, politics, money, relationships, or achievement to provide what only Christ can provide?

Pursue Spiritual Maturity

Evaluate: Am I growing in biblical knowledge? Am I bearing fruit? Am I becoming more patient, joyful, and faithful?

Live From Your Identity in Christ

Remember, you are no longer in darkness. You belong to Christ's kingdom. You are forgiven and redeemed. Face daily challenges from the position of who you are in Christ and what He has done for you.

Fix Your Eyes on Christ

Action: Begin each day by asking, "Lord, what do You want today?" rather than "What do I want today?"

Commit to Christ in Every Area

- Intellectually - Am I growing in biblical truth?
- Volitionally - What choices do I need to submit to Christ?
- Exclusively - What rival is competing for Christ's place in my life?
- Inclusively - Am I meaningfully connected to the body of Christ?
- Irrevocably - Is there any area where I am keeping a backup plan instead of trusting Christ fully?

Weekly Challenge

- Read Colossians 1 every day this week.
- Memorize a verse that stands out to you.
- Begin each morning praying, "Lord Jesus, have first place in my life (in everything) today."
- Identify one area where Christ does not have supremacy and intentionally submit it to Him.
